On March 12 and 15, concurrent breakout sessions will address planning and zoning board operations, SEQR, zoning codes, new planning strategies, flood mitigation and additional specific subjects.

On March 22, presentations will be made on recent land use law cases, FOIL practices and ethics considerations. This session is eligible for CLE credit.

On March 12, the County Department of Planning will present an update on the *Westchester 2025: Plan Together* initiative and new assistance for local planning and comprehensive plans.

On March 15, Keynote Speaker Dr. Floyd Lapp will address the topic, *Robert Moses: Visionary or Villain?*
