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


Estimated Components of Population Change Westchester County, 2000-2010



Change in Total Population by Census Tract Westchester County Subdivisions, 2000 to 2010






Percent Change in Total Population by Census Tract Westchester County Subdivisions, 2000 to 2010






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Population Distribution by Race/Hispanic Origin and Age Westchester County, 2010



Change in Race/Hispanic Origin Westchester County, 2000 to 2010








Foreign-born Entering Since 2000 by Census Tract Westchester County Subdivisions, 2007-11






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
Educational Attainment Westchester County, 2011




School Enrollment for Population 3 Years and Over Westchester County, 2000 to 2011



Household Income Distribution Westchester County, 2011




Median Household Income (2011 dollars) by Census Tract Westchester County Subdivisions, 2007-11






Nativity of Resident Workers*by Occupation Westchester County, 2011


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Population Projections 2010 to 2040 Westchester County




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
Population by Age/Sex Composition Westchester County and The United States, 2010



2010 to 2030 Population Change by Broad Age Groups




Persons Age 65 and Over by Census Tract Westchester County Subdivisions, 2010






Percent Age 65 and Over by Census Tract Westchester County Subdivisions, 2010





Change in Persons Age 65 and Over by Census Tract Westchester County Subdivisions, 2000 to 2010






